Old Business

Signage

New Business

- Water board easement and treatment plant
 - While designing a new treatment facility, we need to work with the water and sewer district to validate and clarify their easement rights to assure their correctness with current and future usage.
 - Troy proposed engaging Burt Willie to draft up appropriate language for this easement. Jaimi motioned and Jay seconded to move ahead with engaging the lawyers on this. Passed unanimously.

Backup generator

An anonymous person has donated a very large backup generator for the treatment plant. This generator was previously supporting a large hospital, so there was discussion on whether it could power the whole neighborhood in the event of a power outage.

Spring water drainage

- Troy has checked some of the areas that were troublesome last year, but not found issues. Ask the community to keep an eye on spring runoff water problems damming and issues that may surface.
- The culvert that goes underneath lower Maple and Pineview is clear. One specifically going under lower Maple is a metal culvert and will eventually need to be replaced.
